G4B entertains, enlightens and engages the audience by sharing informal anecdotes about the music being performed and the musicians performing it. The quartet features members of the *Oklahoma City Philharmonic* including violinist Densi Rushing, cellist Jim Shelley, and harpsichordist Peggy Payne. Steve Goforth, principal trumpet of the *Bartlesville Symphony* also performs with the group.

These instruments are usually thought of in a serious vein, but the ensemble has a good time with their audiences, from a Royalty Suite by Philidor to a Tango by Piazzolla. **G4B** is comprised of outstanding musicians who simply love making music....any kind and anywhere!
